Singing

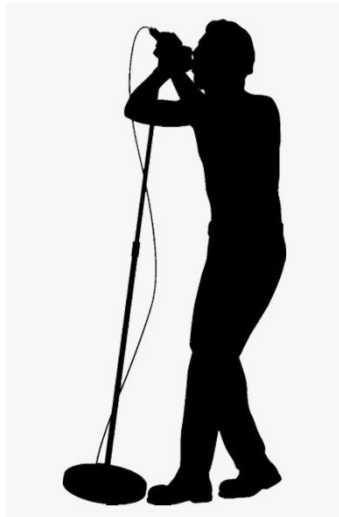
Timing – 4.00PM to 6.00PM
