Green Practices Audit

We observed the following points during the Site investigation. The Institution has undertaken the following initiatives through excellent efforts towards save environment measures before pandemic. The NSS Department holds the nature club and various activities like tree plantation, nature cleanliness, visits to nearby flora and fauna are carried out.

- Signages on the plants mentioning scientific names The practice of having the names of each plant and tree provides awareness among the staff and students.
- Waste water treatment and reuse through septic tank facility.
- The wet waste is sent to the composting pit, where it is converted to organic green compost, which is used in the botanical garden within the premises.
- Seminar on Tree Plantation conducted by Prof. Amelia Antony on 31st August 2019.
- Spcial activity undertaken by NSS as follows.

The College has a very active NSS team. In the year 2015-16 almost the whole of Maharashtra was facing severe drought conditions due to inadequate rains. A small bunch of 29 boys and girls with 2 programme officers from the NSS unit of St. Paul College, Ulhasnagar 4 landed in the Kishor village. It was decided to construct five bunds across small streams passing through the village. With enthusiasm and dedication, the 29 students immediately set about constructing bunds. In five actual working days these NSS volunteers constructed five bunds and were elated to see as water started building up and forming deep pools. The villagers came in hordes to see the miracle unfolding before their eyes. In the evening, the cattle going back to their stables halted and drank water to their heart's content. For making the highest number of bunds with the smallest number of volunteers, and for making such a drastic impact on the economic conditions of the farmers of Kishor Village, Prof. Madhur Kanade was awarded with the Best Programme Officer Trophy of Thane region The Thane Zillah Parishad has allotted Kishor Gaon to St. Paul College for 5 years and they have adopted it with the promise to bring happiness, joy and economic freedom to the farmers of Kishor gaon.
