Eligibility

Criteria for Eligibility:

Students passing an examination equivalent to Std XII of the Higher Secondary Board, Mumbai or from other states and immigrating from other Universities, Boards and seeking admission to the First Year of the 3 Years Degree Courses will be admitted only on production of "Provisional Eligibility Certificate" as stated under 0.111 of Mumbai University.

0.111: Students from another University or Board of Secondary or Intermediate Education or any other Statutory examining body seeking admission to the University shall apply to the Registrar for a statement of eligibility. Such students who have passed HSC from other than Maharashtra Board shall be required to pay fee of Rs.1300/- only towards Verification, confirmation of eligibility and processing charges. Students from other than Maharashtra State Board should apply for and submit to the college verification letter from their respective Boards/ Universities of their mark sheets before the end of first term. The Registrar may issue a provisional statement of eligibility if he is satisfied that the applicant is prima facie eligible for admission to this university. On production of such a provisional statement of eligibility, a student may seek provisional admission to this university at his own risk and on condition that he submits to the Registrar's office through the Head/Principal of his Institution/College, the necessary certificates in original together with a typed copy of each for confirmation of his eligibility before the close of the academic term in which the student is provisionally admitted to the University. No students from another University shall be admitted to any institution maintained by or affiliated to the University except on production of a provisional statement of eligibility issued by the Registrar.

• BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (B.Com.)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the three year degree course leading to the Bachelor of Commerce must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

OR

Must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination with vocational subjects/minimum competency based vocational course conducted by the different Divisional Boards of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

OR

Must have passed an examination of another University or Body recognized as equivalent to Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) Examination.

Every candidate admitted to the degree course in the constituent/affiliated college/recognized institution, conducting the course, shall have to register himself/herself with the University.

• BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (ACCOUNTING & FINANCE)

• A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting and Finance) degree course shall have passed XII std. Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent and secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate at first attempt (40% in case of reserved category).

• Every candidate admitted to the degree course in the constituent/affiliated college/recognized institution, conducting the course, shall have to register himself/herself with the University.

• BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (BANKING & INSURANCE)

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Banking and Insurance) degree course should have passed XII std. Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Pune, or its equivalent and secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate (40% in the case of reserved category candidates) at one and the same sitting. Every candidate admitted to the degree course in the affiliated colleges conducting the course shall have to register / enroll himself / herself with the University.

• <u>BACHELOR OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES (B.M.S)</u>

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the B.M.S. Degree Course shall have passed

H.S.C. Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination or Diploma in any Engineering branches with two years or three years duration after

S.S.C. conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Maharashtra State or its equivalent examination by securing minimum 45% marks for general category (in one

attempt) at the respective Examination and minimum 40% marks for the reserved category (in one attempt).

The admissions are purely based on merit duly following the reservation policy as per the norms of Government of Maharashtra. While drawing the merit list, weightage has to be given to students from Arts, Commerce and Science Stream at 12th standard level. The stream wise weightage to be given is as under: Commerce (45%), Arts (25%), Science(25%) and Diploma in Engineering and Other (5%). The applications will be accepted and processed stream wise separately and the merit list will be displayed stream wise taking into account the reservation policy prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra.
